## Batman to return to the Monterey Peninsula

**MONTEREY, Calif.** — The caped crusader, Batman himself, is returning to the Monterey Peninsula and he'll be doing it with the Batmobile.

The man who created the authentic Batmobile from the 1989 movie, the same Batmobile that made appearances at Cherries Jubilee in downtown Monterey is bringing the Batmobile and his batman costume back to help spread joy to local kids who are sick and to help raise money for children's services.



Many of the best-known characters will accompany Batmobile appearances in full costume, including Batman, Alfred the butler and super villains like Catwoman, the Joker, Poison Ivy and Harley Quinn.

The Central Coast man behind the Batmobile wants to remain anonymous just as Bruce Wayne did so he can preserve the mystery behind batman's identity.

"Kids don't have a hero, they need a hero these days. And they need someone to help them through the dark passages of their life. You know, hopefully these kids will become crusaders of kindness, will do kind things

and not necessarily let everyone know who's doing it. I would like to share that with them. That's important that they do kind acts without accolades," explained Batman.

Currently, the new Batmobile is in the process of being built, but it won't be long before it'll make its first public appearance in Monterey's 4th of July parade.
